Ahtahkakoop Band Membership;

It is very important to get your child(ren) registered before April 30th, 2012, so they may be included in the Treaty Land Entitlement Cut-Off date of April 30th, 2012.

I have worked in the area of Membership since January of 2011. One of the most important aspects of membership is to make sure that our children get registered. The most important reason for registering children as soon as possible is to ensure your child is eligible for the health care they are entitled to. A baby is always covered for health care until they are one year of age, but after that, if they are not registered, they are no longer eligible for that health care, and parents are finding that they are paying for medicines.

Based on information that was in my office, I have been contacting parents and getting out applications, and working on amendments (if need be) so their children can get registered. Sometimes the process of registering a child can be a little more difficult than just signing the Child Application for Registration. One of the greatest difficulties I have come across is when a father has not signed the Live Birth Registration in the hospital when their baby is born. It is important to start the process of registering a child **as soon as they are born.**

The Live Birth Registration that is signed in the hospital ensures that a child's birth certificate includes his parent's names on it. If the father's name is not on the birth certificate, this can affect a child's eligibility for registration. If this is the case, an amendment will have to be done. These can take time and be frustrating for a parent. Once again, this is why it is important to start the process of registering a child as soon as they are born.
